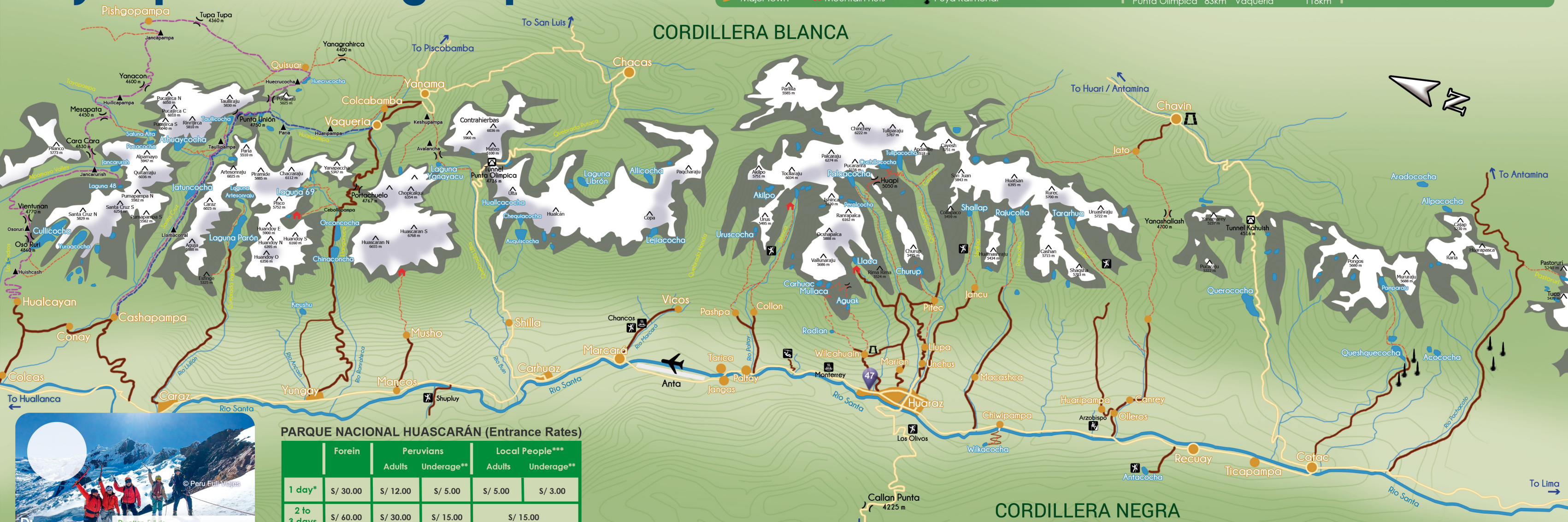

Pico Mateo
 Duration: Full day.
 Distance: by bus 6h, round trip / Climb 4h.
 Highest altitude: 5,150 m (Summit Mateo).
 Difficulty: Easy

Mateo is a peak of the Contrahierbas mountain located in the province of Carhuaz, considered easily access and recommended for those who are started with mountaineering.

Laguna Uruscocha
 Duration: Full day.
 Distance: by bus 2h, round trip / Hike 1.3h - 1.2h.
 Highest altitude: 4,380 m (Laguna Uruscocha).
 Difficulty: Easy/Moderate

It is one of the most beautiful lagoons of the Cordillera Blanca with a turquoise color and located in Urus valley, north east of Huaraz. A quiet and peaceful place, besides being one of the more simpler and less steep hikes in the Cordillera Blanca.

Laguna Llaca
 Duration: Full day.
 Distance: by bus 3h, round trip / Hike 1h.
 Highest altitude: 4,474 m (Laguna Llaca).
 Difficulty: Easy

Located in the Llaca ravine, the landscape that surrounds the lagoon is composed of rocky elevations and abundant flora, a unique place to see the greatness of this part of the Cordillera Blanca.

Laguna Aguak
 Duration: Full day.
 Distance: by bus 40min, round trip / Hike 1.3h - 1.2h.
 Highest altitude: 4,500 m (Laguna Aguak).
 Difficulty: Moderate/Difficult

A good alternative hike for acclimatization in the Cordillera Blanca with an excellent panoramic view of the city of Huaraz and the Cordillera Negra. The trek begins in Wilkahuain, during the hike we can enjoy the unique landscape of the Andes.

Laguna Radian
 Duration: 1/2 day.
 Distance: by bus 2h, round trip / Hike 1.3h - 1.1h.
 Highest altitude: 3,899 m (Laguna Radian).
 Difficulty: Easy

The lake is located northeast of the city of Huaraz, with spectacular and panoramic views to Huascarán, Hualcan and Copa mountain. The trek starts in the traditional andean village of Pucyac, with splendid views of the Andean flora.

Laguna Rajucolta
 Duration: Full day.
 Distance: by bus 2h, round trip / Hike 1.3h - 1.2h.
 Highest altitude: 4,300 m (Laguna Rajucolta).
 Difficulty: Easy/Moderate

This hike goes through a small valley, Rajucolta is a peaceful and strategic place to get excellent views of the mountains in the Cordillera Blanca. A magnificent circuit for a first day of acclimatization in the Andes.

Laguna Parón
 Duration: Full day.
 Distance: by bus 6h, round trip / Hike 1h.
 Highest altitude: 4,155 m (Laguna Parón).
 Difficulty: Easy

Paron is the largest lagoon of the Cordillera Blanca and from there, on a clear sky day, you can appreciate the peak of Artesonraju and the mountains Pyramid, Huandoy North, Pisco, Chacaraju as well as Paria.

Viewpoint Wilkacocha
 Duration: 1/2 day.
 Distance: by bus 40min, round trip / Hike 1.2h - 1.1h.
 Highest altitude: 3,750 m (Laguna Wilkacocha).
 Difficulty: Moderate

This beautiful hike starts close to Huaraz at the Santa Cruz bridge (3100m). We pass traditional Andean villages and local people on the way up. The lake is located in the Cordillera Negra, with spectacular and panoramic views to the mountains of the Cordillera Blanca.

Laguna 69
 Duration: Full day.
 Distance: by bus 6h, round trip / Hike 1.3h - 1.2h.
 Highest altitude: 3,750 m (Laguna 69).
 Difficulty: Moderate

This beautiful turquoise blue lagoon is located at the foot of Chacaraju mountain. To reach this place we start our hike in Cebollapampa, we follow a magical trail along the right side of the river that descends from Laguna 69.

Laguna Churup
 Duration: Full day.
 Distance: by bus 2h, round trip / Hike 1.2h - 1.1.5h.
 Highest altitude: 4,450 m (Laguna Churup).
 Difficulty: Moderate

One of the most visited and popular lagoons within the Huascarán National Park, an ideal acclimatization hike. The trail starts in the town of Pitec. Close to the lagoon we can appreciate the beautiful mountain of the same name whose majesty is reflected in the crystalline waters of the lagoon.

Chavin
 Duration: Full day.
 Type of tour: Bus tour (Nature & Cultural).
 Highest altitude: 4,516 m (Cahush tunnel).
 Difficulty: Easy

The best-known archaeological site for the Chavin culture is Chavin de Huantar, located in the highlands of the Ancash Region. It is believed to have been built around 900 BC and was the religious and political center of the Chavin people. It has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Pastoruri Glacier
 Duration: Full day.
 Type of tour: Bus tour (Adventure).
 Highest altitude: 5,000 m (Pastoruri Glacier).
 Difficulty: Moderate

A glacier that is located in the southern part of the Cordillera Blanca, within the Huascarán National Park declared Natural Patrimony of Humanity in 1985. We will find small lagoons formed beneath the melting ice cap, a sign of the climate change and the quick retreat of the glacier.

Lagunas de Llanganuco
 Duration: Full day.
 Type of tour: Bus tour.
 Highest altitude: 3,850 m (Chinanococha).
 Difficulty: Easy

During the trip you will visit several villages in the Huaylas valley, enjoying breathtaking views of the Cordillera Blanca, to finally enter the Huascarán National Park where we will find two lagoons: Orconococha and Chinanococha with their turquoise waters.
